**ACCEPTING
JESUS?**



ADMIT

The first step of a salvation prayer is to ADMIT our sin. We disobey God in sin, making us imperfect and separating us from Him. Because God is perfect and cannot be around sin, we cannot be with him as we are. This step allows us to acknowledge we are not enough on our own.

PRAY: Jesus, I admit that I am not perfect. I have sinned and tried to do things my own way. I am ready to surrender my life to you and your plans.

SCRIPTURES: Romans 3:23;
Romans 6:23

BELIEVE

The second step of a salvation prayer is to BELIEVE that Jesus was born and lived a perfect life, died an undeserved death for our sins, and was resurrected on the third day. This step allows us to acknowledge the work of Christ and his sacrifice on the cross.

PRAY: I believe that Jesus died on the cross and rose again. Thank you for paying the price for my sins so that I can live with you forever one day.

SCRIPTURES: John 3:16;
Romans 5:8

CONFESS

The third step of a salvation prayer is to CONFESS that Jesus is Lord. We believe that Jesus is strong enough to save us when we trust in him and call upon his name. This step allows us to acknowledge the power, divinity, and lordship of Jesus in our life.

PRAY: I confess that you are the one true God, and I am choosing to give my life to you and follow your ways from this day forward. Amen.

SCRIPTURES: Romans 10:13;
John 1:12
